Maths

- Number and Place Value
- Addition and subtraction

- Recognise and join in with predictable phrases.

- Spelling words ending in 'y' (adding the suffix 'y' to make an adjective)
- Read aloud their writing clearly enough to be heard by their peers and the teacher.

Art and Design/Music

- To design and paint pictures of pants decorative pants.
- To design and make a pair of fabric pants for your teddy to wear at a Teddy's Pants Party.
- To sing songs and play instruments to match different rhythms.



Computing

- To learn about E-safety.
- To design a pair of pants using the Colour Magic programme.
- To use Microsoft Word to change the size, colour and font of text and write a caption about their pants design.
- Design a front cover for a book.



Science

- To identify and name a variety of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water and rock
- To describe the physical properties of a variety of everyday materials
- To compare and group together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of their simple physical properties.
- To observe closely using simple equipment
- To use this knowledge to design and make pair of pants.
