The outcome of the experience

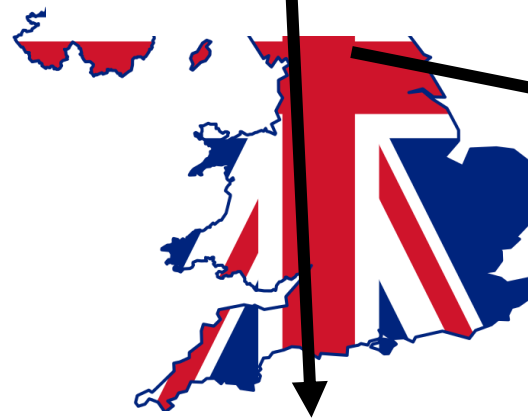
By the end of the experience the children will have a better understanding of the UK- what makes it so special, it's place in the world and how each aspect has similarities and differences.
