We will be learning about:

Throughout this experience, children will learn about a significant turning point in British history that happened during the Tudor Period. This will include the impact of Henry VIII and the start of a new religion – The Church of England. In English we will continue using the power of reading teaching scheme focussing on a children's classic fiction related text. Children will be taught about the great artists in history. Our art will focus on the work of Hans Holbein and re-creating portraits in his style. In learning experience, children will learn about Tudor life styles and significant events that occurred in Tudor times.
