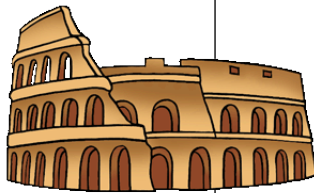

### We will be learning about:

In this learning experience we will be continuing to develop a chronologically secure knowledge and understanding of British, local & world history. Within this, we will be exploring the Roman Empire and its impact on Britain. We will learn about Julius Caesar's attempted invasion in 55–54 BC and the successful invasion by Claudius and conquest, including Hadrian's Wall. We will also be learning about The Celts and their resistance, including Boudicca.

### Maths

In our Maths sessions for this learning experience, we will be looking at Roman Numerals. The children will be learning about the numbers up to 100 (I to C). We will also be rounding numbers, adding & subtracting fractions, finding equivalent fractions.
