Science

We will be carrying out experiments to investigate the changing states of water, focusing on reversible changes including dissolving, melting, boiling, condensing, freezing and evaporating. We will also look at the part that condensation and evaporation play in the Water cycle.

English

We will be reading the story of 'The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe' and exploring the characters and plot ideas through drama and role play. The children will then plan and write their own adventure story set in an imaginary world.
