

Learning Experience Curriculum Outline for Year 3

This will start from: 22nd February - 4th March 2016

Literacy

In Literacy, we will be revising key skills through focused grammar sessions. This will include extending our use of vocabulary, using a variety of punctuation correctly and adding more detail to our sentences through use of powerful verbs, adverbs and higher level connectives.

Outcome

This half term the children will be learning about the properties of different rocks and minerals and classify them into groups. They will carry out scientific experiments to investigate how rocks and soils are formed.

PSHCE

This term we will be focusing on how it is 'Good to be me'. We will be celebrating the children's talents and achievements.

PE

Our main focus for PE will be working towards creating a gymnastics routine using a variety of movements and balances. We will also focus on playground games focusing on working as a team and problem solving skills.

Science

We will be investigating the properties of a wide range of rocks and minerals including their origins, permeability, appearance and uses. We will also be looking at how soils differ depending on their location.

HOOK

In order to engage the children in this new learning experience, we will be planning an orienteering rock hunt. The children will work in small groups to find different types of rocks hidden around the school.
