



Learning Experience Curriculum Outline for Year 3

This will start from 7th March - 24th March 2016

Outcome

For the next few weeks the children will be learning about life in the Stone Age. We intend to provide learning experiences that are as practical as possible so that when asked to write a diary as 'a day in the life of Stone Age man', they will have a wealth of ideas.

DT

We will look at natural building materials that would be available in our woodlands. Finally we hope to create models of simple stone age huts.

English

We will be learning the features of effective diary writing. During our outdoor sessions we will rehearse vocabulary and plan our writing. We will orally tell stories and recounts of our activities around the camp fire, just as Stone Age people would have. Grammar sessions will continue to focus on sentence punctuation and word groups, in particular, adjectives and powerful verbs.

History

We will use a timeline to plot the Stone Age in the history of Britain. We will learn how the Stone Age people lived, what they ate and how they survived. By looking at Stonehenge we will ask questions about how and what they may have worshipped.


