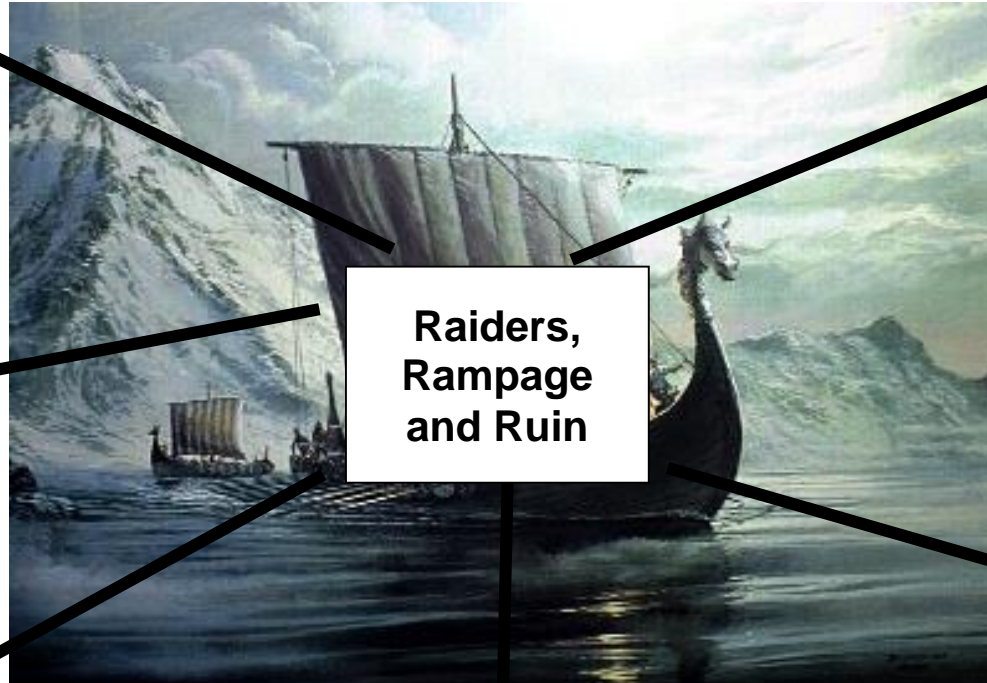


Learning Experience Curriculum Outline for Year 5.

The learning taking place

History

- To study Anglo Saxon Britain and the Viking invasions of the late 8th, 9th and 10th century.
- To research Viking culture, housing, clothing, Gods and religion.
- Use secondary information to find out about King Alfred the Great and a unified Britain up until the battle of Hastings 1066.

- To investigate forces including air resistance and water resistance.
