



Learning Experience Curriculum outline for Year 3.

English

- We will explore the book Mouse Bird Snake Wolf by David Almond and compare it to ancient Greek Myths.
- Continued focus on spelling, handwriting and extending the richness of language in our sentences with adverbs, prepositions and conjunctions.
- Reinforcement of using possessive apostrophes correctly when writing independently is also needed.
- We will be reading, listening to and comparing a range of myths and legends from Ancient Greece.

Art and DT

- We will be looking at structures, resulting in the children planning, designing and making their own Ancient Greek Sandals.
- We'll also be building Greek temples (so please start saving cardboard tubes!)

- Working towards Sports Day, we will learning about the ancient Olympic Games and how they have influenced our modern day athletics.
