- I can identify the location of hot areas of the world in relation to the Equator.

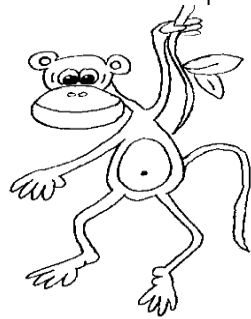
Maths
