



# Learning Experience Curriculum Outline for Year 3

This will start from: 4<sup>th</sup> June - 13<sup>th</sup> July 2018



**English**

We will be listening to, reading and writing poetry. The children will learn some poetic structures and will rehearse their own poems. They will perform poems that they have written in front of parents. The children will learn to recognise the present perfect tense. We will continue to practise spelling patterns, handwriting and guided reading for comprehension.

**Outcome**

This half term the children will be learning about the parts of plants and their functions and exploring rainforests and how different animals have adapted to live in these environments.

**Geography**

Children will be exploring tropical rainforests and their location in the world, including Brazil. They will learn how this ecosystem functions and the threats that face it.

## GREEN PLANET



**PE**

Our main focus for PE will be athletics, preparing for Sports' day. We'll also be teaching rounders and similar team games.

**Science**

We will be investigating the growth of plants and understanding what conditions help them to thrive. In addition, we will be finding out what parts make up a flower and their function.

**Computing**

The children will learn how to use Excel to input and select data, and create a graph to compare the climate in Brazil and the UK. They will continue to work on word processing packages.

For this half term the homework has the theme of conservation and saving the environment. We are focusing on rainforests in class, however the children can look at any area of global or local conservation and present their findings in a method of their choice.
