My name is Fran Steer and I am part of the Pastoral Team here at Sherwell Valley. As part of my role, I am also the Family Support Worker.



Here at Sherwell Valley, we understand that children can only achieve their best when they feel safe, happy and secure. Consequently, we work hard to ensure our children's pastoral needs are considered as carefully as their academic needs.

My main aim is to work with you to support wellbeing (for you and your family) and address any pastoral concerns that you may have. I will be open and honest and am here for a coffee and chat. I may not have all of the answers but hopefully I can help you to work out how to find them!



Support can include:

- Advice to encourage good attendance and punctuality.
- Promoting self esteem, confidence and positive behaviour.
- Providing support with life changes and difficulties including anger, emotions, bereavement and separation.
- Advice on how to manage particular home situations as a parent, enabling your child to be ready and prepared to learn.
- Offering your child support and someone to talk to.
- Ways to establish boundaries or routines.
