● Uniform

We ask that all children wear the correct school uniform (and bring the correct PE kit) to school and that this is named. Our policy is on the school website.

Trainers and sports socks are permitted, they must be completely black with no coloured logos.

No jewellery is to be worn to school. Earrings must be studs only. A watch is permitted as long as it has not got the function to connect to the internet or take photos.

PE days –

● Ensuring the children have what they need

Children need to bring their reading diaries with them to school along with their water bottles. They need their PE kits which can remain in school. Children do not need to bring in additional toys or sensory resources as any child that needs sensory tools will be provided with them during the school day by school staff.

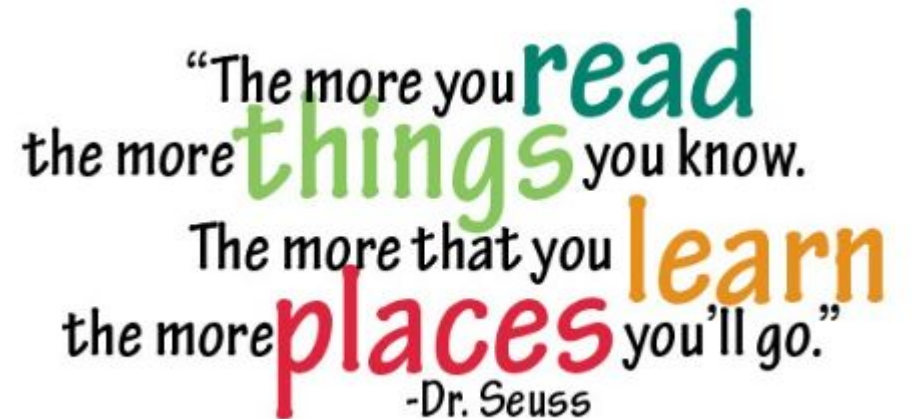
Snacks – Children can have a healthy snack a breaktime. It may be worth discussing this with your child each day as to which is their healthy snack.

Reading

Our curriculum books and class texts are chosen to inspire high quality outcomes and further support the curriculum.

We encourage the children to read as much as possible both at home and school.

In the Early Years and Key Stage 1 we teach children to read through Read, Write Inc. They then progress to reading skills lessons. This is all reinforced through library sessions, class story books and dedicated time to read.
